Bowie Senior Signs NCAA National Letter of Intent

Paige Juneau, a Senior at Bowie High School has signed a National Letter of Intent to play NCAA Division II Womens Lacrosse for the Fort Lewis Skyhawks in Durango, Colorado. Paige hopes to pursue a degree in Exercise Science.

Paige has been playing Lacrosse since 2005 as a Freshman on the Bowie JV Team. She is currently the leader of the defensive squad and Team Captain of Bowie's Varsity Lacrosse Team. She also plays for the Texas Play Hard Outlaws, an elite traveling team where she honed her skills to prepare for this year's Texas Girls High Lacrosse League (TGHSLL) season.

This past summer, Paige played in the National Amateur Championships in New Jersey and in January played in the Adrenaline Lacrosse Challenge in San Diego, where she won tournament All-Star honors. Her elite team Coach Jo Owens says, “Paige's leadership on the field and excellent stick skills will make her a outstanding addition to any collegiate program.”
